

MARMARIS

Explore the vibrant city of Marmaris, renowned for its lively atmosphere, both day and night. Visit Marmaris Castle & Museum and Old Town (Kaleiçi).

Take a Jeep safari and explore pine forests, mountain villages, waterfalls, and dirt roads. Marmaris Grand Bazaar is great for shopping and finding bargains. The beach is lined with bars and night clubs for those looking for some lively nightlife. Go and have a Turkish bath and massage at the many Spa's.

We will board from 16:00 and overnight in Marmaris.

DAY 02

EKINCIK BAY

Before breakfast, we will depart for Ekincik Bay, where a light breakfast will be served near the location.

Located southeast of Marmaris, we will meet a riverboat that will transport us to the ancient site of Caunos, situated in the Dalyan River delta. Following the visit to Caunos, the boat will continue upriver to the renowned sulphur mud baths.

The expansive sandy beaches of the Dalyan delta are home to one of the last remaining breeding sites for the Mediterranean Sea Turtle, Caretta. Please note that the Dalyan Caunos Historical Tours are available at an additional cost; kindly inquire for further details if you are interested.



DAY 03

BEDRI RAHMI BAY

The Gulet will depart from Ekincik Bay early in the morning and then anchor in Manastir Bay for lunch, followed by a refreshing swim in the crystal-clear waters.

In the afternoon, we will continue our journey to Bedri Rahmi Bay (also known as Taşyaka Cove), named after the renowned Turkish poet and painter. In 1974, he carved a fish figure into a rock on the shoreline, you can still see it today. You can swim ashore and take short nature walks among the trees.

We will anchor in this serene and picturesque bay, where we will spend the night.





DAY 04

GÖCEK

In the morning, we will set sail for Tersane Island, a historic location where the local people built wooden ships centuries ago. The remnants of the ancient shipyard can still be seen today, offering a glimpse into the region's maritime history.

Later in the day, we will continue our journey to Göcek, where we will anchor for the night. Göcek has a small, relaxed town center with restaurants, cafes, and boutique shops. Hiking in the surrounding hills offers stunning panoramic views of the bay and islands.

Scuba diving and snorkeling opportunities are abundant, especially around the small islands and rocky coves.

DAY 05

FETHIYE

After breakfast, we will depart from Göcek and sail to Kargi Bay, a beautiful and captivating destination where you will have plenty of time to enjoy swimming, snorkelling, and windsurfing. In the afternoon, following lunch, we will set course for the resort town of Fethiye.

Visit Amyntas Rock Tombs – Ancient Lycian rock-cut tombs overlooking Fethiye, a must-see heritage site with great views. Fethiye Museum displays Lycian, Roman, and Byzantine artifacts. Paragliding from Babadağ Mountain that is a world-renowned paragliding spot with breathtaking aerial views of Ölüdeniz and the peninsula.



DAY 06

DISIBILMEZ

In the morning, we will cross the vast expanse of Fethiye Bay to Disibilmez. T

his little bay is a paradise for snorkelling fans. What is even more interesting is that it is also a meeting place for many kinds of fish just waiting to be caught! Good luck to any fishermen aboard.

The surrounding pine hills and coastlines are great for peaceful walks, especially if you want to enjoy the view and the fresh Mediterranean air.





DAY 07

MYRA ISLAND

Following breakfast, we will set sail for Kadirga Bay where after a long sail in the open sea, we will spend some time swimming, surfing, and snorkelling.

Then we sail on to Myra Island, for the last dive into the clear waters on the outskirts of Marmaris Bay. Later we will anchor close to Paradise Island, where we will enjoy dinner as the sunsets over Marmaris to the West.
